

## New Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP)

LIHWAP is a temporary emergency program that will help eligible low-income households afford water & wastewater services, providing a one-time payment directly to the utility company. ## IMPORTANT WATER NOTICE:

Beginning March 7th, 2022 until approximately April 11th, 2022, the City of Kinston will temporarily change the disinfectant used in the water treatment process from chloramines to chlorine. During the temporary switch to free chlorine, customers may notice a slight change in the taste or smell of their tap water. The mild chlorine taste & smell is normal and poses no health risk. People and businesses that normally take special precautions to remove chloramines from tap water, should continue to take the same precautions during the temporary switch.

## CITY COUNCIL UPDATES

The following are some highlights of the City Council meetings from Nov 2021 – March 2022 (see the full minutes at [kinstonnc.gov/AgendaCenter](http://kinstonnc.gov/AgendaCenter)):

- Council approved to permit car wash/detailing in the B-2 Zoning District (Downtown District).
- The City recognized 2 retirees from the City. Michael Spencer and Donald Leland, thank you for your years of service and dedication to the City!
- Approved the pay raise of 3% to 19% increase for full-time City positions. The increase will depend on grade, length of service and experience. Funding will surface from general funds, enterprise funds, and frozen positions.
- BakerTilly was selected as the search and recruitment firm for the City Manager search.


