Cold weather energy saving tips:

- Set your thermostat between 68° & 72°.
- Check for air leaks throughout your home! 1/3 of a home's total heat loss is through unsealed windows & doors.
- Set ceiling fans to spin clockwise, this helps push warm air that has risen to the ceiling back down into the room.
- Close doors of unused rooms. Don't waste valuable heat by keeping unused spaces open during the cold months.

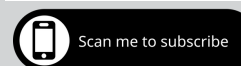
